"Days of Atheism" are organized each spring in Warsaw by Polish atheists to commemorate the death of the great atheist Kazimierz Lyszczynski and to affirm freedom of conscience.

The event is a celebration of atheism which, each year attracts increasing numbers of atheists from Poland and from around the world. It includes the Atheist March and the historical reenactment of the execution of Kazimierz Lyszczynski, as well as lectures, panel discussions, exhibitions and film screenings. One of the key events is a Gala Dinner with the Atheist of the Year Award Ceremony in national and international categories. Among the winners of this Prize there are such distinguished atheists as Maryam Namazie from Iran/GB) and Sanal Edamaruku from India/Finland (2014), Waleed el-Husseini from Palestine/France (2015), Mario Ramadan from Lebanon (2016), Michael Nugent from Ireland and Fauzia Ilyas from Pakistan/Netherlands (2017), David Silverman from USA and Rahma Essid from Tunis (2018).

About KAZIMIERZ LYSZCZYNSKI

Kazimierz Lyszczynski also known as Casimir Liszinski (1643 - 1689) - Polish philosopher, who was accused, tried and cruelly executed for atheism. In the treatise "De non existentia Dei" he asserted that God, being "a creation of a Man", does not exist and that "Religion was constituted by people without religion" with the aim of oppressing simple people.

Kazimierz Lyszczynski was the most eminent Polish mind of 17th century, a men far ahead of his time. Yet, he is forgotten in Poland and totally unknown abroad. It's a high time to render him a historical justice and let him join the greatest thinkers of his epoch such as Giulio Cesare Vanini or Giordano Bruno.
